Dear Parents,

It's great to be back in Term 2. There are lot of activities coming up in the next few weeks with Cross Country next Friday at Corndale.

This week we were lucky enough to be invited to Channon Public School to watch a performance of Dana Lyons. This will be a great experience for our year 2-6 students.

This term will also see a lot of preparation towards our Athletics Carnival which will take place on the last Monday of the school Term. More information will come out closer to the date.

As our two incentives for the term the school will have a mid-term movie afternoon in week 5. This will be a fundraiser for our SRC and will be attended by all students who have not been on a behaviour card in weeks 1-5.

In the last week of term 2 we will have our annual excursions with 3/4 heading to Dorroughby for a two night excursion which will be appropriately \$140. Our senior students, 5/6 will be heading to Midginbil in the same week. This excursion will be

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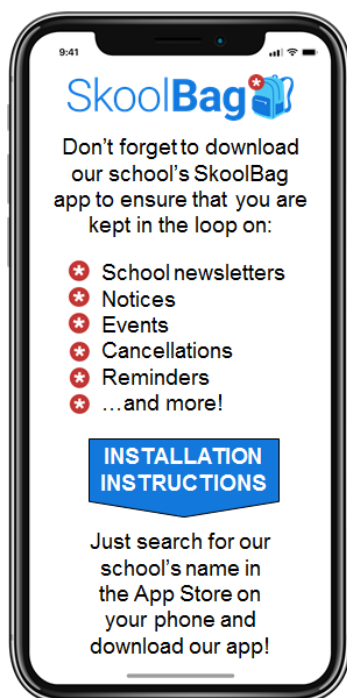

- All competitors should compete in school uniform.

The 'Sandy Hunter Cross Country Shield' will be presented to the champion school based on total points divided by school enrolment. Points will be allocated down to 20th position in each race.
